### **Key messages**

#### **Forecast (21-31 March 2020)**

- Widespread rainfall activity is expected in the Southern and equatorial countries of GHA
- Thermal discomfort is expected in Central and northern parts of South Sudan


#### **Observed rainfall (1-10 March 2020)**

- **Significantly drier than normal** conditions observed in Southern Tanzania.
- Very Good than usual average rainfall observed in southern and coastal parts of Tanzania, southern, central and western parts of Kenya, eastern parts of Uganda.
- Unusual high daytime temperature anomalies is recorded in western Sudan and eastern Kenya and Unusual hot nights is recorded in most parts of Kenya

## Rainfall Forecast 21-31 March 2020



Range	Category
<1 mm	No rain
1 – 10 mm	Dry conditions
10 -50 mm	Light rain
50 -100 mm	Moderate rainfall
100 - 200 mm	Heavy Rainfall
> 200 mm	Very heavy

#### **Forecast**



**Heavy rainfall above 200 mm** forecasted in some regions of south eastern, northern & western Tanzania and western Burundi



**Moderate rainfall in the range 50-200 mm** is forecasted in much of Tanzania, Rwanda, Burundi, central Kenya, much of Uganda, north western Somalia and central Ethiopia



**Light rainfall in the range of 1-30 mm** expected in northern South Sudan, parts of central Ethiopia and parts of northern and central Somalia



**Dry conditions are forecasted** in Sudan, northern South Sudan, northern Ethiopia, much of Eritrea and western Djibouti

#### **Alerts**



**Widespread rainfall** activity is expected in the Southern and equatorial countries of Eastern Africa

#### **Expected Impacts**




**Positive impacts:** Improvement in water quality and accessibility, favorable agricultural conditions, pasture and food security in most parts of Tanzania and Burundi, Rwanda, Uganda, southern, western and central Kenya. **Negative impacts:** Possible outbreak of water and vector born diseases such as Malaria in southern and equatorial countries of the region

## Temperature Forecast 21-31 March 2020



Range	Category
< 18°C	Low temperature
20°C - 30°C	Moderate temperature
> 30°C	High temperature

#### **Forecast**



**High mean temperatures above 30°C i**n much of South Sudan, northwestern and Eastern Kenya, southwestern Somalia, parts of southeast Ethiopia and southern parts of Sudan



Moderate conditions in the range 20-30 °C in much of Sudan, Uganda, Tanzania, southern & western Kenya, northern Somalia, Djibouti, Eritrea and parts of eastern & northern Ethiopia



**Mean temperatures less than 18 °C** in central Ethiopia, parts of central & western Kenya and isolated regions in Rwanda, Burundi, Tanzania, Eritrea, and Somalia

#### **Alerts**



**High temperature discomfort** in central and northern parts of South Sudan.

#### **Expected Impacts**




**Thermal discomfort** expected in Central and northern parts of South Sudan.

#### **Advisories**



People in Central and northern parts of South Sudan advises to take some measures such as shelters and shades to reduce the high temperature discomfort.

# Observed rainfall (Percent of normal) 1-10 March 2020



Range	Category
< 30 %	Much drier than normal
75 – 30 %	Drier than normal
75 -125 %	Near normal
125- 200 %	wetter than normal
> 200 %	Much water than normal

#### **Anomalies**



**Much drier than normal** conditions in central Ethiopia and southern Tanzania.



**Drier than normal** conditions observed in central Ethiopia, northeastern Kenya and southern Tanzania



**Near normal** conditions observed in areas adjusted to Lake Tanganyika in Tanzania, northern Burundi and Southern Rwanda.



**Wetter than normal** conditions observed in much parts of western Tanzania




**Much wetter than usual average** observed in southern and coastal parts of Tanzania, southern, central and western parts of Kenya, eastern parts of Uganda.

#### **Alerts**



Flash floods observed in some areas in Southern Tanzania.

## Observed Maximum Temperature anomalies 1-10 March 2020



Range	Category
<0.6 °C	Warmer than normal
-0.5 - 0.5°C	Normal temperature
>0.6 °C	Cooler than normal

#### **Maximum Temperature anomolies**



**Warmer than normal** maximum temperature (daytime hotter than usual) recorded over western Sudan, South Tanzania, eastern and coastal parts of Kenya



**Normal day time temperature** recorded in northern Sudan, western Ethiopia, central and southern Uganda, everywhere in Burundi, Southern Kenya and most parts of Tanzania




**Cooler than average maximum temperature** (daytime cooler than usual) recorded over most parts of South Sudan and northern Somalia

#### **Alerts**



**Unusual high daytime temperature anomalies** is recorded in western Sudan and eastern Kenya

# Observed Minimum Temperature anomalies 1-10 March 2020



Range	Category
<0.6 °C	Warmer than normal
-0.5 - 0.5°C	Normal temperature
>0.6 °C	Cooler than normal

#### **Minimum Temperature anomalies**



**Warmer than average** minimum temperature (nighttime hotter than usual) recorded over most parts of Kenya, central Uganda, Southwestern Tanzania and southern Somalia



**Normal temperature** recorded in Darfur region and eastern Sudan, eastern Ethiopia, northwestern Tanzania, Southeastern South Sudan, Northeastern Uganda and northwestern Kenya.



**Cooler than average** minimum (nighttime cooler than usual) recorded over eastern Sudan, Southeastern and northwestern Ethiopia.

#### **Alerts**



**Unusual hot** nights is recorded in most parts of Kenya
